

**JEFFERSON DAVIS PARISH SCHOOL BOARD
JULY 30, 2020**

The Jefferson Davis Parish School Board met in Special session at 203 E. Plaquemine Street, Jennings, LA 70546, on Thursday, July, 30, 2020, at 6:00 p.m., with the following School Board members present: Members, Phillip Arceneaux, Jason Bouley, Charles Bruchhaus, Donald Dees, David Doise, Malon Dobson, James Segura, Denise Perry and Paul Trahan. Absent: Greg Bordelon, David Capdeville, Terry Leger and President, Jody Singletary.

The meeting was a live stream access meeting and the following School Board members were present for discussion purposes only: Greg Bordelon and Jody Singletary.

The record will reflect that all requests for public participation were sent info by Mrs. Duhon.

The meeting was opened by Vice-President, James Segura, with an invocation by JES Principal, Mr. Harper, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the U.S. flag led by Mr. Arceneaux.

Motion by Mr. Arceneaux, seconded by Mr. Dees unanimously carried to that the Board call for a vote to take care of items of business not listed on the original agenda or to change the order of topics to be addressed.

Motion by Mr. Dobson, seconded by Mr. Bruchhaus unanimously carried to grant permission to Laurie Duhon, Technology Supervisor, to enter into a one-year contract with Amplified IT to obtain a district license for Google Enterprise for Education at the cost of \$11,880.00. Without this license, we lose all premium privileges for Google Meet to conduct virtual meetings and training sessions, including the ability to record virtual sessions. The district will gain added security features within our current Google Admin Console and will gain full access to Originality Reports within Google Classroom. This rate is discounted at 50% and will lock pricing in for year two and year three should the district wish to continue services beyond this year.

Motion by Mr. Dees, seconded by Mr. Arceneaux to discuss the school calendar for the 2020-2021 school year and due to COVID19 pandemic possibly push back the start date of school.

After lengthy discussion, motion was made by Mr. Doise and seconded by Mr. Dobson to start the school year as planned on August 17, 2020. Mr. Doise requested a roll call and the vote was as follows:

Upon roll call vote the motion passed.
