SEAC Meeting Minutes

Mr. Jeremy Fuselier called the meeting to order by offering a prayer.

The notetaker did the roll call and present at the meeting: Chairperson Mr. Jeremy Fuselier, Mrs. Dana Simar, Mrs. Myisha Nixon, Mrs. Laci Lemieux, Mrs. Tiffany Pitre, Ms. Ashlynn Pitre, and Mrs. Susan Reihn. Absent: Mrs. Holly Landry and Mrs. June Abshire. Mr. Fuselier welcomed everyone and discussed team members' term of membership until 2026.

Called on Mrs. Susan to give all an update on Families Helping Families: Santa drive, dates office closed, and Mardi Gras Ball.

August 2024 meeting minutes were read and the floor was opened for a motion to accept the minutes. Motion to accept by Mrs. Tiffany Pitre (Parent); seconded by Mrs. Laci Lemieux (Parent).

Old business discussed was the 3rd annual Special Olympics—70 plus students, BBQ for the students, different sport stations, ribbons handed out. Solicited ideas on how to get more parents to attend. Middle and high school bowling with Calcasieu was a great success. 3rd annual Transition Expo-largest attendance and number of vendors thus far. Mrs. Pitre and A. Pitre interviewed by KPLC. MNRI was invested in as a therapeutic training for all schools to be proactive and to give them the skills they need to assist those who may struggle with emotional regulation and learning. Special education teachers, regular education teachers, paraprofessionals, and administrators across the district participated in the training. Supporting elementary schools-The Special Education Playbook with Bailey's Group: focus on core instruction, extra time to learn, and content strong teachers.

In new business, the chairperson shared that they were trying to find a vendor to support Pre-K students. Discussed upcoming January 17th PK-2 Special Olympics day at JHS and March 21st or 28th Track and Field day. He re-stated a partnership with incoming Sheriff Kyle Myers and explained that these funds will be used to continue providing these social activities for the SWD in PreK to 12th grade. First parent night training with possible zoom link to be planned. Topic will be focused on understanding the IEP. Next step will be scheduling the parent night with a firm date and a tentative time of 5:30; need donations for snacks. Future topics to include understanding accommodations and modifications and April Dunn.

Chairperson continued with SPED spotlight and testing highlights. Reviewed the Plan of Proposed/Refused Action, high dosage tutoring, and 3rd grade promotion/retention along with

the Good Cause Exemption. Other comments: LASARD is providing support to SWD and Tier 3 MTSS students. Ripple effects is being implemented for behaviors for students with behavior goals and a behavior intervention plans.

Reminded all that the next school dance would be May 2, 2025. The next meeting date was shared 5/1/2024 at 3:00 pm and Mr. Fuselier stated that an email invite would be sent. A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by Mrs. Laci Lemieux and it was seconded by Mrs. Myisha Nixon.
